CITY OF DURHAM AND US DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION – FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION – UED22 -FY 2021 AND FY 2022 FTA SECTION 5310, ENHANCED MOBILITY FOR SENIORS AND INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES FUNDS GRANT PROJECT ORDINANCE AND ATHORIZATION TO EXECUTE GRANT AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Durham has been awarded a grant by the Federal Highway
Administration through the North Carolina Department of Transportation for conducting a
transportation planning project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Durham deems this activity to be a worthy and Desirable undertaking of City staff; now therefore,

NOW, THEREFORE PURSUANT TO N.C.G.S. 159-13.2, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DURHAM THAT:

- Section 1. The ordinance is a grant project ordinance concerning a FTA Section 5310 grant funds, as described in the Durham-Chapel Hill-Carrboro Metropolitan Organization (DCHC MPO)

 Coordinated Public Transit Human Services Transportation Plan, Program Plan and GoDurham, Chapel Hill Transit, Durham County ACCESS and Orange County STEAMM 5310, and will be valid until completion of the grant projects or funds are expended.
- Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute the agreement and other documents that are required or appropriate in order for the City to receive FTA Section 5310 grant funds for Section 5310 approved projects. The FTA Section 5310 grant funding will be used in conjunction with financing allocated within the state/federal match budget of the Transportation Department.
- Section 3. The following revenue is anticipated to be available to the City of Durham to complete the project:

- Section 5. The grant matches to be provided by the Town of Chapel Hill, GoDurham, Durham County and Orange County are reflected in this ordinance.
- Section 6. Within five days after the adoption, the City shall file a copy of this
 Ordinance with the Budget Director, Director of Finance, Accounting Services
 Manager and the Transportation Planning Manager. A copy of this ordinance shall be filed in
 the office of the City Clerk and shall be available for public inspection as provided by law.
