<b>Protect Environment and Minimize Climate Change Environmental &amp; Economic Sustainability</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Is there another term besides sustainability? It doesn't seem to match well, especially with environment.</li><li>Try "protect environment" and "support economy."</li><li>These two terms are huge. Why are they together? Separate them!</li><li>Split environment and economic.</li><li>Make Goal #8 an economic theme with freight in a sub position.</li><li>Put environment with land use.</li><li>Add climate change.</li><li>Public health, natural environment and cultural resources don't fit under climate change.</li><li>Try "quality of life."</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><del>A. Link land use with transportation</del> (moved to Economic goal)</li><li><del>B. Increase funding and funding sources for all transportation modes</del> (moved to Economic goal)</li><li>C. Reduce mobile source emissions, GHG, and energy consumption</li><li>D. <b>Reduce the impact on the natural and cultural environment</b></li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Objective C should stay with the environment goal.</li><li>Objective B is a good one.</li><li>Objective A might stay the economic goal.</li><li>Change Objective A to "Link land use <u>and</u> transportation" because the influence goes both ways.</li><li>We want to balance energy, asset acquisition and use.</li><li>Besides reducing pollutant emissions, we also want to "reduce the impact on the natural and cultural environment."</li></ul>
<b>Connect People Network Accessibility</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Combine with congestion to simplify the goals.</li><li>Most important thing is to "connect people."</li><li>Is "connectivity" a better term?</li><li>Try "network connectivity."</li><li>Is there another way to say it? I am not sure what network accessibility means.</li><li>Network means wireless to me.</li><li>Get rid of "network." Try "system."</li><li>Accessibility brings up mobility impairment issues.</li><li>Try "transportation access."</li><li>Try "comprehensive transportation network."</li><li>We are trying to say that the system takes you to a lot of different places.</li><li>What are the multiple modes? How do we help them?</li><li>Use a verb to start the Goal statement.</li><li>Try "promote access."</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><del>A. Improve accessibility by auto and transit</del></li><li>B. <b>Connect people to jobs, education and other important destinations using all modes</b></li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Try "promote connectivity."</li><li>Use "people!" So, it would be "connect people to jobs, education and other important destinations."</li><li>Stations are infrastructure. Can we take the objective down to that level?</li><li>Try "promote connectivity for all modes and trip purposes." Don't just focus on work trips.</li></ul>

<div>Promote Multimodal and Affordable Travel Choices</div> <div><del>Alternative &amp; Affordable Travel Modes</del></div>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Suggest “multimodal travel choices.”</li><li>Also, keep “affordable” in this goal.</li></ul>	<div>A. Enhance transit services, amenities and facilities</div> <div>C. Improve bicycle and pedestrian facilities</div> <div>D. Increase Improved utilization of affordable non-auto travel modes</div>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Try “improve bicycle and pedestrian facilities.”</li><li>Need to add pedestrian to Objective B.</li><li>Promote separated bicycle facilities rather than shared facilities.</li><li>Objective A is good.</li><li>Change Objective A to “Enhance transit services, amenities and facilities.”</li><li>Objective C should be “Promote utilization of...”</li><li>Besides providing the infrastructure, we need to promote the lifestyle change to using alternative modes more.</li><li>Add affordability into these objectives.</li><li>Explicitly add carpool, vanpool, park-and-ride lots, TDM into these objectives.</li><li>We need to find a way to promote or do small projects, as well.</li></ul>
<div>Manage Congestion &amp; System Reliability</div> <div><del>Congestion Reduction &amp; System Reliability</del></div>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Some congestion on roads is OK to push users to other modes.</li><li>Predictable congestion is OK.</li><li>This is congestion management.</li><li>With this priority, all modes except cars are negatively impacted while cars get the green light.</li><li>Be sure to remember all modes.</li><li>System reliability applies to all modes.</li><li>This can lead to overdesign of roadways for cars.</li><li>This can be accomplished with policy and utilization, e.g., don’t allow deliveries during peak hours.</li></ul>	<div>A. <del>Ensure maximum regional mobility and reliability</del> Allow people and goods to move with minimal congestion and time delay, greater predictability in all modes</div> <div>B. Promote Travel Demand Management (TDM, such as carpool, vanpool and park-and-ride)</div> <div>C. Enhance Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS, such as ramp metering, dynamic signal phasing and vehicle detection systems)</div>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Be sure that this applies to all modes, not just cars.</li><li>Provide definition and examples of Objective B.</li><li>Provide definition and examples of Objective C. How it can be used and is used.</li></ul>

<b>Improve Infrastructure Condition</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>How to capture NCDOT's role and responsibility?</li> <li>Reporting process/method.</li> <li>Differentiate between NCDOT and local jurisdictions.</li> <li>State of repair.</li> <li>Add verb/action word.</li> <li>Ease of reporting/timeliness of repair and response.</li> </ul>	<p>A. Increase proportion of highways and <del>highway assets of transportation infrastructure and other assets</del> in 'Good' condition</p> <p>B. OMM – Operations; Maintenance; Management (amenities and welcoming).</li> <li>Funding and process for reporting systems.</li> <li>Improve response time for small repairs (define small repairs).</li> <li>Investments for performance longevity/maximize life cycle performance</li> <li>Placemaking amenities/improvements.</li> <li>Define “good.”</li> </ul>
<b>Ensure Equity Environmental Justice and Community Values</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Disproportionate burdens to any community.</li> <li>Accessibility/soliciting community input.</li> <li>Separate community values – all of the goals are community values.</li> <li>Spell out all modes.</li> <li>Consider verb or action-oriented word to introduce goals.</li> <li>Respecting neighborhood input.</li> <li>Construction cones should not be the first time citizens have heard of the project.</li> <li>Public engagement separate good.</li> <li>Take out “various” in the definition.</li> </ul>	<p>A. Meet the transportation needs for all populations (especially the <del>aging and youth elderly</del>, economically disadvantaged, mobility impaired, and minorities)</p> <p><del>B. Ensure that transportation priorities align with community values.</del></p> <p>C. Minimize the negative effects of transportation investments to the <del>natural environment and</del> local communities</p> <p>D. <del>Ensure that transportation investments do not create a disproportionate burden for any community</del></p> <p>E. <b>Promote Safety and Health</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Include community health.</li> <li>Incorporate safety for wildlife/wildlife corridors.</li> <li>Include reporting mechanism.</li> <li>“Eliminate” rather than “reduce.”</li> </ul>	<p>A. Increase safety of <del>triangle region</del> travelers and residents</p> <p>B. Promote public health through transportation choices</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use more inclusive language in Objective A such as “Increase safety of triangle region travelers <u>and residents</u>.”</li> <li>Improve public/community health. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Increase bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure and activity.</li> <li>Light and sound pollution (also air pollution)</li> </ul> </li> <li>Eliminate fatal and serious injury – “vision zero”</li> <li>Put person foremost</li> <li>Think about individual/traveler in terminology</li> <li>8/80 Cities focus</li> </ul>

<b>Freight Movement and Stimulate Economic Vitality</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Rename goal “Economic Vitality” and put freight as a subset.</li><li>• Is freight on roads moving more at off-peak?</li><li>• All modes should be considered – highway, rail and air – but concentrate on rail.</li><li>• Freight should not be obstructing other purposes of travel.</li><li>• Do not let trucks block roadways for better movement.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>A. Improve freight movement</li><li>B. Link land use and <del>with</del> transportation</li><li>C. Increase funding and funding sources for all transportation modes</li><li>D. Improve project delivery for all modes</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Use policies on delivery time, etc. to improve efficiencies.</li><li>• Concentrate on modes other than truck.</li><li>• Final distribution is important. For example, impact delivery has on other modes and downtown area.</li><li>• Don’t let deliveries impede others.</li><li>• Promote rail freight movement but don’t impede non-freight movement and negatively impact community, e.g., downtown Durham.</li><li>• Increase funding for all transportation modes.</li><li>• Link transportation and land use. Connect key land uses with major transportation destinations.</li><li>• Improve freight movement.</li></ul>
<b>Reduced Project Delivery Delays</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• This should not be a goal. Make it an objective under another goal.</li><li>• This is a process. Perhaps incorporate it into Goal 3, Goal 4 and elsewhere, as needed.</li><li>• Very good goal.</li><li>• Good goal.</li><li>• New working – “Efficient project delivery.”</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>A. <del>Accelerate project completion and improve agencies' work practices</del></li></ul>
