Recap from P7

- We received a large response from our members during the initial project submission period
- We narrowed the candidates to 24 submissions per mode and presented these to the public
- Later in the Fall, we then solicited input from the public on our project selection process and criteria for assigning Local Input Points
- Ultimately, the results of P7 were limited by the Funding Availability

As a Result

- The Methodology for Selecting Projects will be separated from the Methodology for Assigning Local Input Points
- The Methodology for Assigning Local Input Points will take place in the Fall
- Scheduling has been adjusted to 2025 meeting dates

What does this document do?


- Presents to the public the MTP Goals that guide the selection of projects

Initial Submissions

- Currently only accepting new project submissions
- No limit to the number of submissions
- Highway projects must comply with the MTP
 - Projects expected to be amended into the upcoming MTP will be accepted
 - Projects that are not explicitly stated in the MTP, but align with the adopted goals, will be reviewed by the TPO and may be accepted
- We would like to have new submissions by March 14
