Subject: FY 2015 Unified Planning Work Program – Amendment #2

The Lead Planning Agency (LPA) staff is requesting an amendment to the FY2015 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP). The proposed amendment is necessary in order to allow the following:

- LPA to re-allocate among various task codes in STP-DA and PL and de-obligate STP-DA funds for freight study and travel surveys which will be conducted in next fiscal year.
- Durham County to re-allocate STP-DA funds among task codes to conduct additional work related to Draft Environmental Impact Study of light rail project.
- City of Durham to re-allocate STP-DA funds among various task codes and de-obligate STP-DA
 funds for Durham Bike and Hike Map, Durham Bicycle Boulevard and Bike Lane Study, and
 Durham Bike Share Feasibility Study. These tasks will not be developed this fiscal year. The City
 has proposed an updated pedestrian and bicycle plan in the draft FY 2016 UPWP.
- City of Durham to de-obligate TIGER 6 Planning Grant for Belt Line Trail Master Plan.
- Chapel Hill to re-allocate 5303 funds among various task codes to reflect level of effort needed.
 Chapel Hill will de-obligate STP-DA funds from numerous task codes due to staff vacancies and delay of completion of pedestrian plan to FY16.

The UPWP provides yearly funding allocations to support the ongoing transportation planning activities of the DCHC MPO. The UPWP must identify MPO planning tasks to be conducted with the use of federal transportation funds, including highway and transit programs. Funds that would not be expended during the current fiscal year (FY15) must be de-obligated through an amendment in order for the funds to be available (carried over) for programming during the next fiscal year.
