9. Targets for Safety Performance Measures
David Miller, MPO Staff
Brian Murphy, NCDOT Traffic Safety Unit

David Miller provided a brief overview of the MPO's target setting process for safety performance measures. Brian Murphy, Traffic Safety Systems Engineer from NCDOT's Traffic Safety Unit, provided an overview of the safety performance measures, shared safety data specific to the DCHC MPO urbanized area, explained that the MPO can establish its own targets or endorse NCDOT's targets, and communicated deadlines. David Miller stated that the MPO recommends supporting NCDOT's safety targets by resolution.

Michael Parker made a motion to adopt the resolution that supports NCDOT's safety targets. Jamezetta Bedford seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

# 10. Public Hearing: -Amendment #1 to the FY 2024-2033 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Filmon Fishastion, MPO Staff

Colleen McGue filled in for Filmon Fishastion. Mrs. McGue asked for a motion to open the public hearing. Javiera Cabellero moved to open the public hearing. Jamezetta Bedford seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. Colleen asked for public comments. There were no public comments. Javiera Caballero moved to close the public comments. Jamezetta Bedford seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. Colleen discussed Amendment #1 to the FY2024-2033 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) which included

the addition of funding to existing projects as well as adding new projects from the FY24 Call for Projects. The amendment also includes carryover adjustments from FY2020-2029 TIP Amendments 6, 9, 13, 14, 15, and 16. These amendments were already approved by the Board in previous meetings and are reissued for administrative purposes to reconcile data between the old and new plans, ensuring a more seamless transition into the State TIP (STIP).

Additional projects in this amendment include Item N updates from NCDOT (state provided amendments and modifications), and other such project updates that fall under administrative modifications. Two projects from Item N are not being amended into the TIP now as they are not in the Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP): HN-0013 Erwin Road turn lanes and HN-0014 Cornwallis Road turn lanes.

Jamezetta Bedford made a motion to approve Amendment #1. Javiera Cabellero seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

## 11. FY2025 UPWP Draft David Miller, MPO Staff

David Miller presented the FY 2025 Draft Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP), which included an explanation of the funding sources, amount requested by member agency, priorities, special study requests, and the remaining timeline for public engagement and adoption.

Wendy Jacobs asked if the Chapel Hill Transit High-Capacity Transit Corridor Feasibility Study would interface with what Durham is doing with their corridors. Doug Plachcinski said there will be, as it is part of the Scope Development Study.

Carl Rist asked for an explanation of the Fast Study 2 and the Local Project Delivery Study. Doug Plachcinski explained both studies.

Mark Bell made\_a motion to release the FY2025 UPWP draft for public comment. Lisa Mathis seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

The goals and objectives survey was publicly released on November 16, 2023, and closed on January 15, 2024. Other engagement efforts included: pop-up events at Durham Station, the Boxyard, and the Regional Transit Center; newspaper advertisements in the Triangle Tribune, Que Pasa, and the News & Observer; and direct outreach to community groups. Results of the survey will be presented at the biannual joint meeting of the DCHC MPO and Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (CAMPO) Boards on January 31, prior to the Boards reviewing for approval.
