


*Transit and active transportation are expected to receive a relatively higher share of funding in the following two decades.






- 2050 MTP Highway Projects Adjustments:

 Way Conversion
 - Other
- New Projects/Adjustments:
 - US-70 East: Boulevard conversion w/ parallel collectors
 - I-885: HOV (or Toll Lane) Lane addition from Briggs Ave via EEC to I-40
 - US-70 West: Widening & multimodal Improvement
 - N Duke St & Gregson St: Speed Reduction & Other safety improvements
 - Other



Types of Managed Lanes

Managed Lanes

- ❖ Toll Lane
- ❖ High Occupancy Vehicle Lane (HOV 2+, or 3+)
- ❖ HOT Lane: HOV lanes with Toll charges for single-occupancy vehicles



- Multi-Modal Integrated Corridor Management (ICM):
 - NC147 & I-885 from Briggs Ave via EEC to I-40
 - US 15-501 North from US15 Business Road/South Square via Patterson Place, Eastgate and NC 54 to S Columbia St
 - NC 54/Raleigh Rd from US15-501
- ❖ I-40 East from I-540 to US 15-501:
 - Managed Freeway which may include ramp meter, dynamic shoulder & so on (but no general-purpose lane addition)
