






Engagement with NCRR





- Active and constructive discussions among NCRR, City of Durham, Triangle Transit
- NCRR defined a footprint for future railroad use
- DOLRT LPA needed refinement due to railroad needs within that portion of NCRR right-of-way
- Recommended approach:
 Pettigrew Street Transitway

Pettigrew Street Transitway



- Ninth St, Dillard St Stations:
 - Roughly same as before
- Buchanan Blvd, Downtown Durham Stations:
 - o Both stations move slightly to East, Buchanan also South
- Alston Ave Station:
 - Station moves to west side of Alston Avenue
- Alignment varies from LPA between Ninth St and Buchanan Blvd, now south of Smith Warehouse
- Alignment closely follows LPA path from Alston Ave to Chapel Hill St, but approximately 15 ft to South of LPA





Benefits of Transitway Approach



- NCRR has provided agreement in principle pending resolution of issues East of Dillard St
- Light Rail/NCRR interaction reduced from approximately 2.8 miles to approximately 1.7 miles
- Light rail will not be elevated through downtown
- Downtown Durham Station co-located with bus hub, bus-torail connections will be improved
- Downtown Durham Station closer to DPAC/American Tobacco
- Alston Ave station may be better positioned to serve NCCU
- DATA and TTA buses can use Westbound Transitway to Durham Station (can also be used by EMS)

Issues Requiring Further Study



- Study needed on traffic displaced from Pettigrew St
- Change in property impacts near Alston Ave and between Ninth St and Buchanan Blvd
- Traffic/Train Operations at Fayetteville St & Pettigrew St intersection
- Updated Cost Estimates Needed
- Updated Ridership Estimates Needed
- Determine Utility Impacts

Timeline for Local Gov't Participation



- Jan 2015 Review Five Key Decisions
- March/April 2015 Local Governments & Public Review Data on Benefits / Impacts of Alternatives
- September/October 2015 Official 45-day comment period: Local Governments and Citizens Make Recommendations to Triangle Transit on Key Decisions and any other DOLRT-related comments
- Fall/Winter 2015 Triangle Transit Develops Final EIS
- Summer 2016 Record of Decision
