6. <u>Proposed DCHC Methology for Ranking Projects and Allocating Local</u> <u>16-115</u> <u>Input Points (SPOT P4.0) (15 minutes)</u> Lindsay Smart, LPA staff

The DCHC MPO's *Methodology for Identifying and Ranking TIP Project Requests* is the process that the DCHC MPO will follow to develop the DCHC MPO's allocation of Local Input Points among projects for input to the STI process. The Methodology will also inform the MPO's development of the Transportation Improvement Program. The Methodology is designed to address the federal requirement that the TIP be consistent with the projects and investment priorities of the MTP while being compatible with the state's STI process.

TC Action: Review and discuss DCHC MPO draft Metholodgy. Recommend that the MPO Board approve the draft Methodology be released for the public review and comment period.

7. <u>Draft FY2017 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) (15 minutes)</u> Meg Scully, LPA Staff

The DCHC MPO is required by federal regulations to prepare an annual Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) that details and guides the urban area transportation planning activities. Funding for the UPWP is provided on an annual basis by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA). The UPWP must identify MPO planning tasks to be performed with the use of federal transportation funds, including highway and transit programs. Attached is the draft FY 2017 UPWP. The draft FY2017 UPWP was released for public comment by the MPO Board on January 13, 2016.

TC Action: Recommend the MPO Board hold a public hearing and approve the plan including a resolution, the self-certification process, and local match at their next meeting on February 10, 2016.

Immediately following the January 13, 2016 MPO Board meeting, MPO staff conducted a workshop for Board members to draft the Goals, Objectives, and Performance Measures for the 2045 MTP. Based on input from this workshop, staff modified the workshop copy of the Goals, Objectives and Performance Measures to create a draft for TC review. An attached document (with the "Draft" suffix) provides a record of the input that the Board provided at the workshop and shows the proposed changes to the Goals, Objectives and Performance Measures. Another attached document (with the "Record" suffix) shows the input that the Board provided at the workshop and the proposed editing to the Goals and Objectives.
