Annually, the DCHC MPO is required by federal regulations to prepare a Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) that details and guides the urban area transportation planning activities. Funding for the UPWP is provided on an annual basis by the Federal Highway Administration and the Federal Transit Administration. The UPWP must identify MPO planning tasks to be conducted with the use of federal transportation funds including highway and transit programs. Attached is the draft FY2015 - 2016 UPWP.

# Amendment #24 to FY2012-2018 TIP (9:20-9:30) Lindsay Smart, LPA Staff

TIP amendment #24 proposes modifications to #C-5179 North Estes Drive and #U-5550 Fordham Blvd & Ephesus Church Road Intersection projects. The proposed modification to the North Estes Drive project is to increase the STP-DA and local match funding for the design/PE phase by a total of \$28,000 from \$220,000 to \$248,000 to reflect higher costs than originally anticipated. The STP-DA funds are made available through the de-obligation of funds in the UPWP. The proposed modification to the Fordham Blvd & Ephesus Church Road Intersection is to amend the project scope & details to specifically include utility relocation. There are no changes to the project cost or schedule. This amendment does not require public review & comment.

# 10. <u>Congestion Management Process (CMP) - System Status Report 2014</u> (9:30-9:45)

The Congestion Management Process (CMP) System Status report was developed in accordance with federal regulations and the CMP Procedures and Responsibilities that the MPO adopted in June 2011. This report provides the state of system performance, recommendations and future directions. The MPO Board released the report at their January 14th meeting for a 21-day public review and comment period. MPO staff received several comments from local staff but did not receive any comments from the public. Based on those comments, the most significant changes made for the final report include:

- Appropriately designated the recommended CMP projects that are funded in the draft FY2016-2025 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP);
- Renamed the walkability measure to the more appropriate term "walk score:"
- Reformatted Table 3, Regional Performance Measures, to group together those measures that can be compared to population change;
- The comparison of peak and off-peak congestion travel times have been updated, resulting in I-40 (Durham) having the highest percentage of additional peak travel time.

# 17. 2015 NCAMPO Transportation Conference

Registration is open for the 2015 NC Association of MPO's statewide transportation planning conference! The conference will be held on April 29-May 1, 2015 at the Raleigh Convention Center, and is hosted jointly by the NC Association of MPO's, NC Association of RPO's and the NC Department of Transportation. The conference registration fee includes a keynote luncheon presentation by Dr. Ruth Petersen, NC Division of Public Health's Chronic Disease and Injury Section, who will discuss the intersection of public health and transportation. The conference will also feature technical sessions in four tracks: Technical Toolkit; Bicycle & Pedestrian Planning; Data Collection & Modeling; and Land Use & Transportation. There will be a reception on Wednesday night at the NC Natural Sciences Museum in downtown Raleigh, which is also included in registration. Various mobile workshops are available as well for an additional fee.

This conference is attended by nearly 300 transportation planning practitioners in the public and private sector, regional planners, transit planning professionals, transportation engineers, TCC members, and elected officials from RPO and MPO boards across the state. The conference is a great opportunity to network with transportation professionals and decision makers across the state and learn more about how transportation challenges are being addressed in various regions of NC.

Conference sessions are being registered for AICP CM credits, PE PDH credits, and Landscape Architecture CEU's.
